

Nurserv

All children are welcome to stay with parents in the Sanctuary during worship. However,



for parents of children ages 0-2.5 years who want nursery care, we have a well-equipped and professionally-staffed nursery at the end of the hall nearest the Sanctuary. Each child brought to the nursery is given a number; only the parents of the child can take the child from the nursery. If a parent is needed during worship, the child's number will appear (in red LED's) on the black panels beneath the hymn boards on both sides of the Chancel. Parents, please bring diapers and any snacks, formula as needed for your child.

Holy Communion

All baptized Christians are welcome to receive the Sacrament. If you have not been baptized, please come to the Altar rail for a blessing during Holy Communion (place your

arms across your chest to signify your desire for a blessing). If you would like to be baptized, please speak with the clergy after the service. To receive Holy Communion, accept the bread in your hand and place it in your mouth, then sip wine from the Chalice when it is brought to you (guide the Chalice to your mouth please), or hold the bread, dip it in the wine when the chalice comes to you, and place the bread with wine in your mouth. If you



are allergic to wheat or are gluten intolerant, please let the person serving bread know to give you a rice wafer.

St. Mathieu's School Update

Interesting facts about a student at St. Mathieu's: all children are required to wear uniforms and pay tuition. There is no publicly funded education. Uniforms are \$25 each and tuition is \$15 per student. And, they must pay for their textbooks and workbooks, about 11 books per child at a cost of approximately \$147. Imagine finding that much money in your budget for one child not to mention two or three, when you are a poor family. It's easy to see why it's not possible for many children to attend school and, why our support is a tremendous blessing to these students.
