
I am excited to announce that, in addition to our Honorary Co-Chairs (the Rev'd. Mary Munch, who was the very <u>first</u> director of St. Timothy's Pre-School in 1975, will be with us to say a few words. The Honorable Keven LeBlanc, Mayor of the Town of Herndon, has also accepted my invitation to speak about the importance of St. Timothy's Preschool to our community. I am grateful to them both, and for Helen and Ralph+, for their presence.

One of the ways that you can get involved is by sharing your memories about St. Timothy's Pre-School and what it has meant to you and your family. I shared this memory on Facebook but will repeat here:

When I was being interviewed to potentially become be the Church's Priest-in-Charge, my family came to tour the church and the school. At some point, the 'formal' part was over and we (my family and the interview folks) were out on the Pre-School Playground where my son could play, and the adults could chat a little more. I realized I had forgotten something, so I went back into the church to grab it. When I came back out, my wife was speaking with Kristie Rudolph and Allyson Showalter and she was crying. I started to walk back a little bit quicker... only to learn that Allyson had been telling her that, if I ended up taking the job, St. Timothy's Pre-School would have a place for our son, and that he would be in good hands with the teachers here, and that that part of the transition would be okay.

She was right! St. Timothy's Pre-School was a caring environment for our son, where he learned to love school, and learned how to learn. He still gives big hugs to his former teachers and loves to come back and, at the age of 7, instruct the current students on what they have to expect in Elementary School.

That's my relationship with St. Timothy's Pre-School. Although I also hold the lofty title of chairperson of the St. Timothy's Pre-School Board, the reason I believe wholeheartedly in the education and the loving atmosphere at the school, is because I have seen it firsthand.





That's my small sliver of knowledge, only 3 years' worth, of our half-century history.
